#### Example Story Summary 1

- 1) I'm 9 years old, and last year was busy but exciting for me.
- 2) One thing I learned last year was how to stay calm when work feels hard.
- 3) My goal this year is to get better at reading longer books.
- 4) I will practice every day and ask for help when I need it.
- 5) At the end of the year, I hope to feel proud and confident.



#### Example Story Summary 2

- 1) I am a student who worked hard last year, even when things were tricky.
- 2) Last year taught me that mistakes help me learn.
- 3) My goal this year is to be more organized with my schoolwork.
- 4) I will use a planner and clean my desk each week.
- 5) I hope the year ends with me feeling proud of my progress.



#### Path B: Full Draft - About 500 words

- Around 500 words total do as much or as little as you can!
- Short sentences
- Use this order:






#### Draft guide

- Where I am now 2–3 lines
- My reflection 2–3 lines
- My goal 3–5 lines
- Action steps 2–3 lines
- My closing 2–3 lines

Write on the worksheet page by page. Think about the 5 part structure you used in planning







#### Show, don't tell

Tell  $\rightarrow$  I felt proud of myself.

Show  $\rightarrow$  I smiled, stood taller, and kept going.

Tell → Last year was hard.

Show → My hands shook, but I finished anyway.

Swap one "tell" for a "show."

# What is a good image prompt?

#### What's a prompt?

It's the sentence that tells the app what to draw on this page.

Your main character stays the same—you change the action, place, and details.

#### The 4 Magic Parts (A-P-O-M)

- Action what is the character doing?
- Place where is it happening?
- Objects 1–2 things to include (props).
- Mood/Time how it feels (cozy, windy) or when (evening, rainy).



# Quick Example Image Prompts

#### **Good Prompt**

"The student writes goals at a desk in the evening; a notebook is open, a calendar is

nearby, and the room feels calm and hopeful."

#### **Not Good Prompt**

"The student at a desk."

#### Why is this not a good prompt? Put your hand up

Remember The 4 Magic Parts (A-P-O-M)

Action + Place + Objects + Mood/Time



# Why is this a bad prompt?

#### **Not Good Prompt**

"The student at a desk."

- Action No Action
- Place "Desk"
- Cbjects No Objects
- Mood/Time No Mood/Time

The bad prompt has not passed

the 4 magic parts!





# Why is this a good prompt?

#### **Good Prompt**

"The student writes goals at a desk in the evening; a notebook is open, a calendar is nearby, and the room feels calm and hopeful."

- Action "Writes goals"
- Place "At a desk"
- Objects "Notebook", "Calendar"
- Mood/Time "Evening", "Hopeful"

The good prompt has passed

the 4 magic parts!


## What is A.I?


# AI = Artificial Intelligence.

- It means computers learn patterns from lots of examples.
- Then they use those patterns to help us: recognize voices, suggest words, translate,

draw pictures from words, and chat.







That's how your character was made!



#### In Build My Story, Al can:

- grow your summary into a story (Help me write)
- make pictures from your prompt (Create new image)

#### Remember!

Al is NOT a person. It has no feelings and can make mistakes.

YOU are the author — check, edit, and choose what to keep.

#### Story Summary → Big Story

#### Image Prompt →



#### Be smart & kind online:

- Don't share private info (full name, address, passwords).
- Ask an adult if something doesn't look right.
